

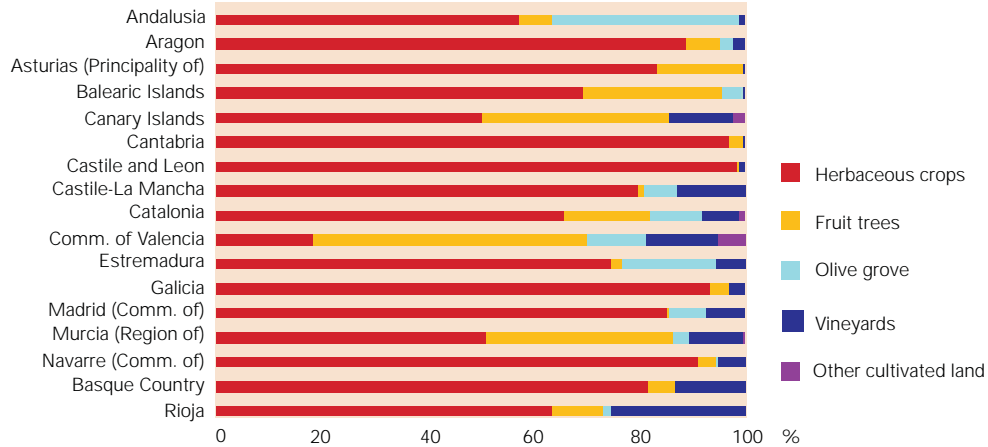

Farm Structures Survey

Its objective is to ascertain the current structure of the agricultural sector and its trend as compared with earlier surveys and the latest agricultural census (1989). It also meets the European Union demand for member countries to implement an agricultural survey programme (one Agricultural Census between 1 December 1988 and 1 March 1991 and sample surveys in 1993, 1995 and 1997).

The survey is conducted nation-wide and covers the farming season from 1 October of one year to 30 September of the next year, considered as the year of reference; the date of reference for

livestock is the interview date. The information is collected in the last quarter of the year of reference by directly interviewing farm owners.

The information units are farms that meet any of the following conditions: have at least 1 ha of utilised agricultural area (UAA); turn over at least 0.2 ha to vegetables and flowers, hothouse crops, irrigated fruit trees or nurseries; livestock farms must be of some economic importance.

The sample surveyed in the 1993 survey (51,350 units) was taken from the 1989 Agricultural Census, and, considering their characteristics, some farms within each autonomous community were constant and others were included using

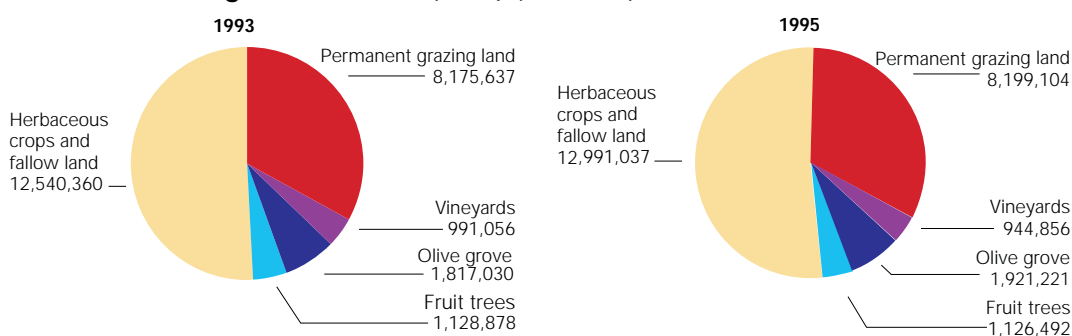
sampling procedures. The same units were used for the 1995 survey, less farms that had shut down since the previous survey and plus new farms included (totalling 48,506 units).

National and autonomous community results are published on utilised agricultural area (farm size, crop type, tenancy system, livestock farmed, irrigated land, family and paid labour, etc.) and on techno-economic orientation (economic size, gross margin, principal orientation).
