Education statistics

They seek to ascertain the two basic variables in the Education System - pupils and teachers- in order to observe variations over time and enable the Public Administrations to make forecasts and take the appropriate measures.

The INE produced these statistics from the 1945/46 to the 1984/85 academic years, when the Ministry of Education and Culture took over production of statistics on primary and secondary education; the INE retained responsibility for Higher Education statistics.

Higher Education Statistics

Their objective is to give an overview of the scope and volume of higher education. The information obtained is also used to complete questionnaires from international institutions.

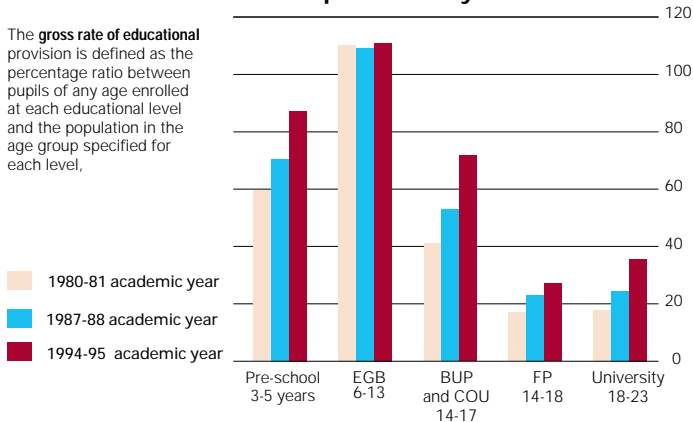
The statistics are produced from the information supplied by universities and higher education institutions throughout the country, regardless of their ownership and class, and referred to the academic year. This information is collected on a questionnaire filled in by the institutions each year.

Tables are published for the whole country and by autonomous community on institutions, teachers, pupils enrolled, newly enrolled pupils and pupils who completed their studies the previous year, referring to both university and non-university studies. Tables on university entrance examinations and PhD studies are also published.

Gross rate of educational provision by educational level

The **gross rate of educational provision** is defined as the percentage ratio between pupils of any age enrolled at each educational level and the population in the age group specified for each level.
